Topic: Case Study Methods and Use of Technology in Teaching”

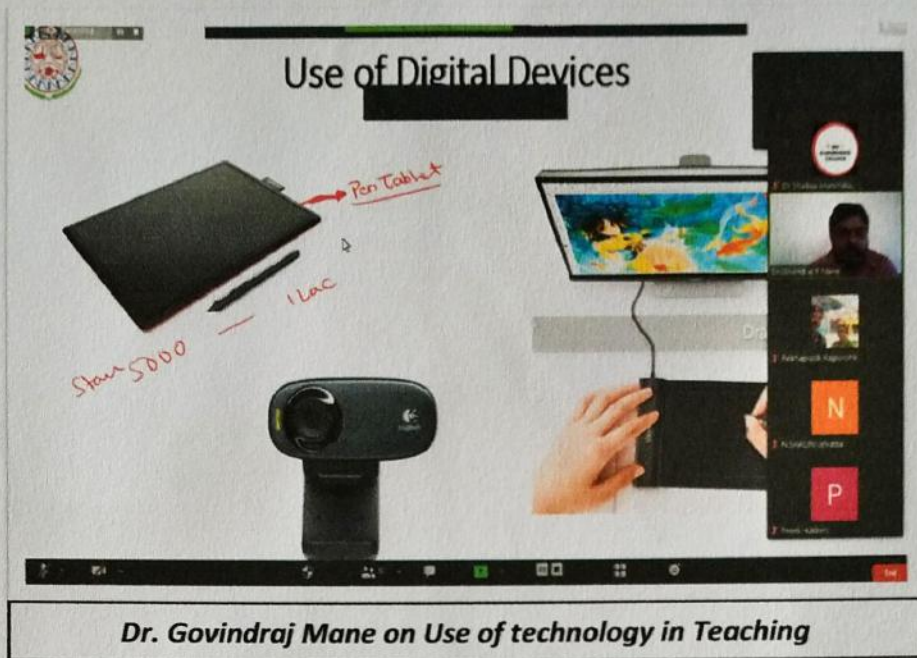
Date: 21 st December 2020

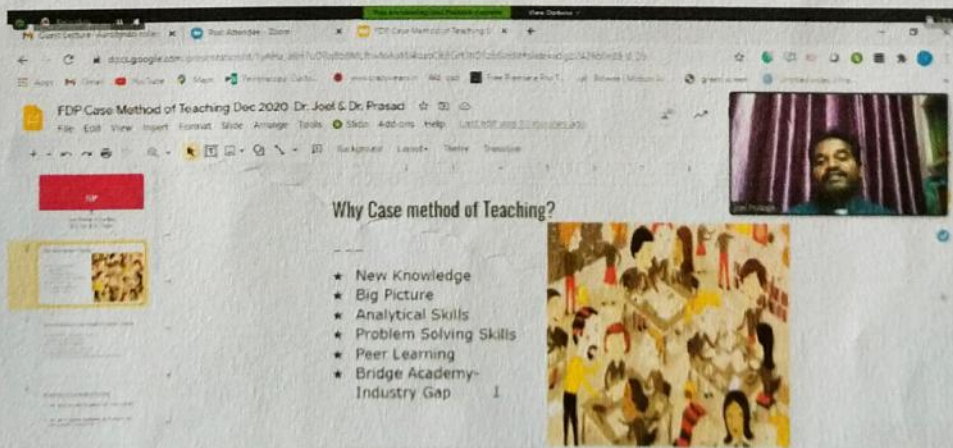

Dr. Govindraj Mane explained about Use of digital devices in the present scenario. He briefed about the various devices that can be used by lecturers for classroom teaching and also the effectiveness of classroom. He also explained about E-learning system and learning management systems. The speaker explained that a learning system based on formalized teaching but with the help of electronic resources is known as E-learning. While teaching can be based in or out of the classrooms, the use of computers and the Internet forms the major element of E-learning. It is a way to provide quick delivery of lessons. As compared to traditional classroom teaching method, this mode has relatively fast delivery cycles. The speaker also mentioned few devices, platforms and methods to all the participants for effective teaching.



Dr. Govindraj Mane on Use of technology in Teaching

Dr. Prasad Kulkarni and Dr.T. Joel Gnanapragash spoke about the different methods of case study analysis. They described case method, is a participatory, discussion-based way of learning where students gain skills in critical thinking, communication, and group dynamics. The speakers addressed the participants about the importance of solving real time case to understand the practical problems of today's corporate world. They mentioned that if students want to gain knowledge or learn analytical / problem solving skills, case method of teaching is the appropriate one. The case study method has a major advantage that the students are energetically engaged in thinking out the values by abstracting from the examples.

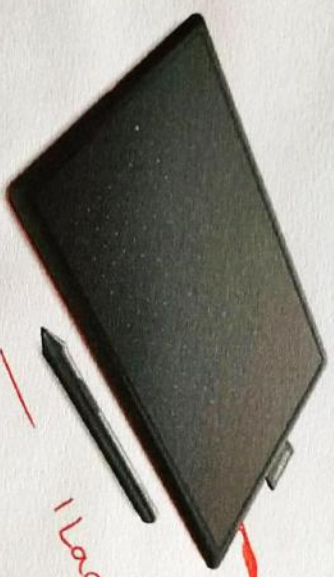
