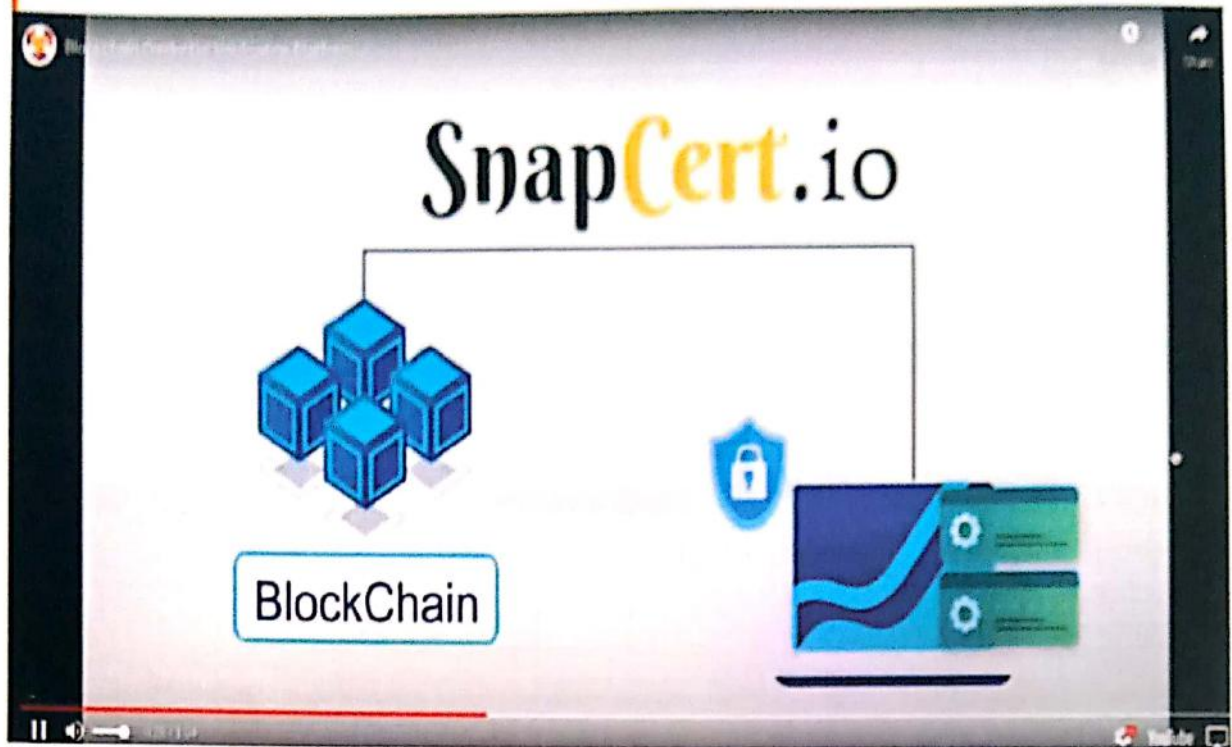


The whole session was focused on the topic Block chain technology.

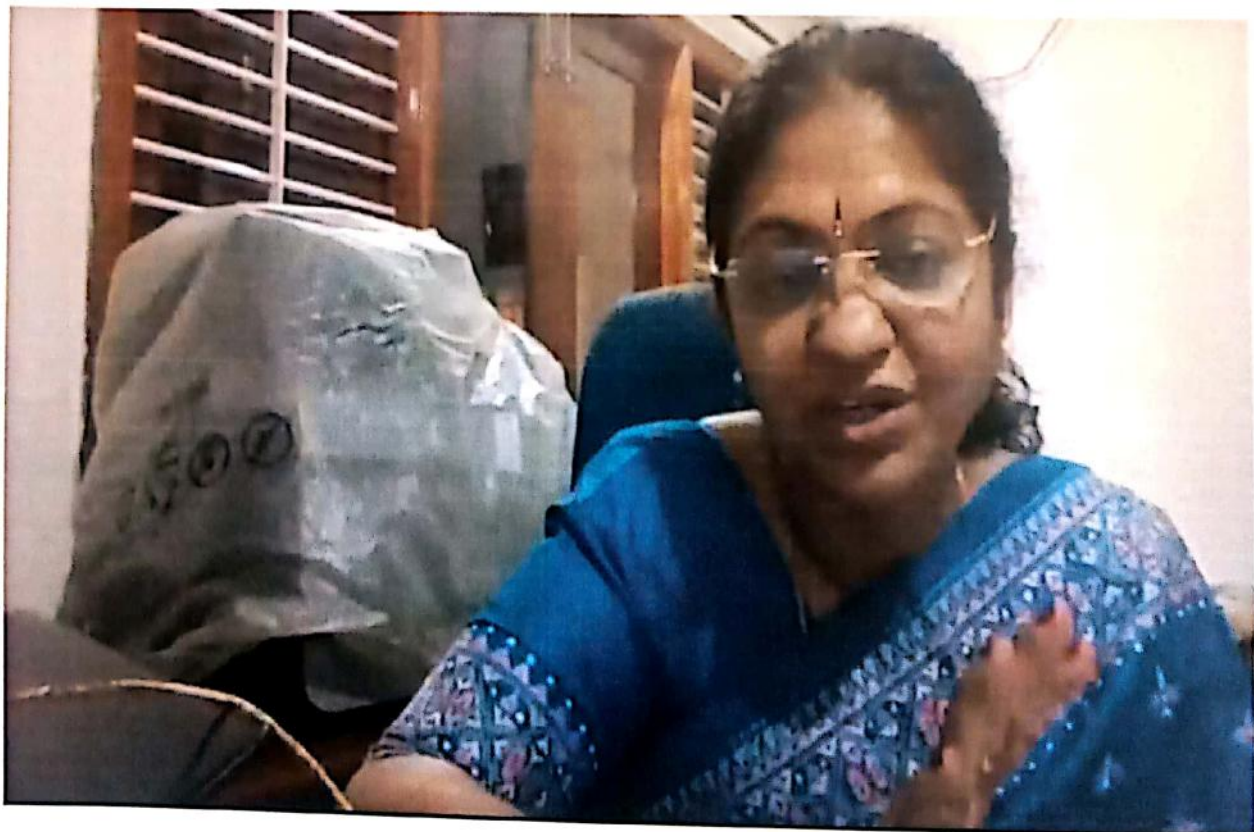
Sir started the session with a question asking the audience, what is Block chain Technology? What it offers and how it is connected through various networks,

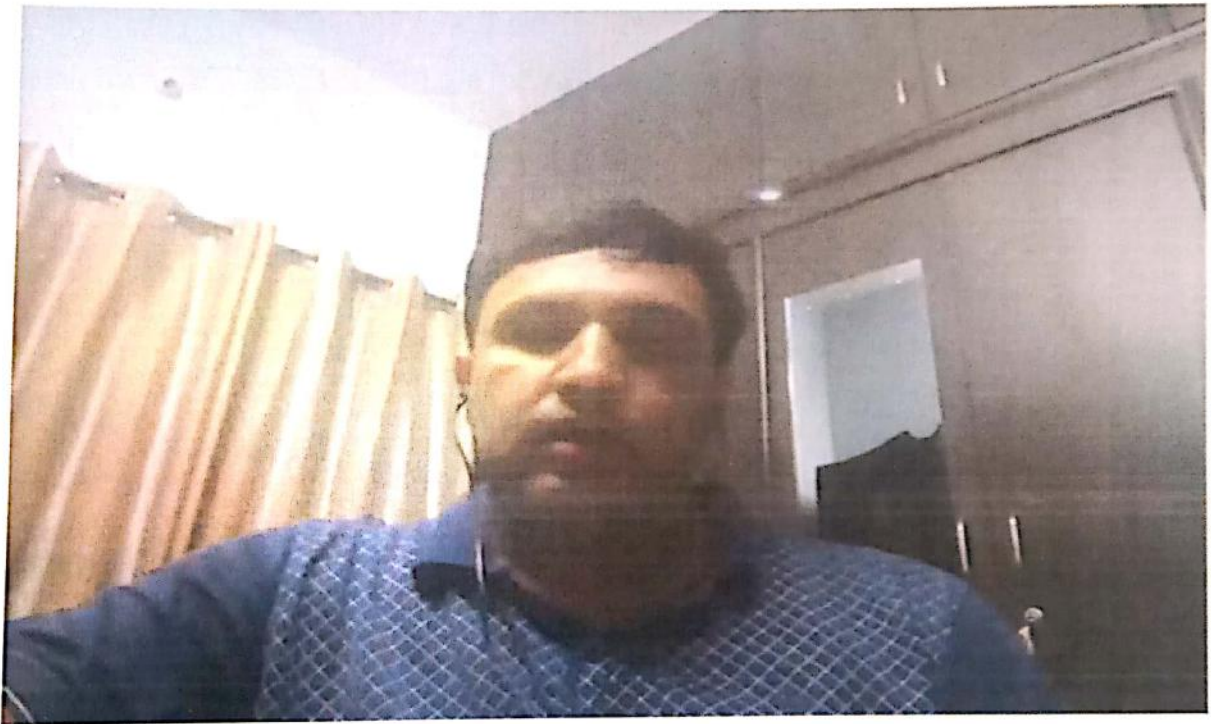
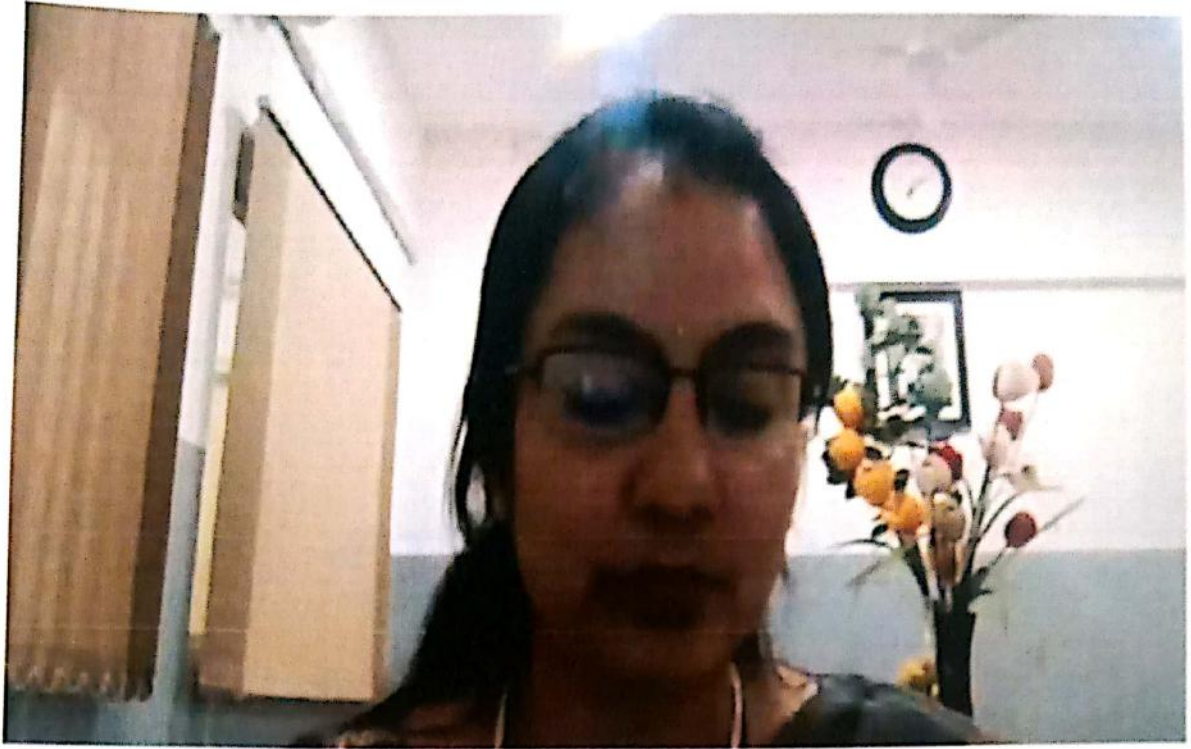
