

SRI AUROBINDO INNOVATION & START-UP POLICY (SAISP)

AWARENESS PROGRAMMES AND STRATEGIES TO IMPLEMENT NISP IN THE INSTITUTION

The following programmes have been conducted under the auspices of SAISP to create awareness amongst the stakeholders, to discuss and deliberate on the strategies on policy formulation, facilities and guidance provided at HEI level.

1. Core-Committee (Hon. Members of the Management, RES), Governing-Council (Experts from Industry/Institution) and Executive Council (Faculty and Students to Implement the policy at Institution level) are formed.
2. All faculty members, students and Alumni were requested to go through MoEs initiatives under National Education Policy the adoption of National Innovation and start up policy (NISP) and offer their considered viewpoints.
3. Regular and Virtual Meetings were held at Faculty level to highlight the novel initiatives of MoE. Brain storming sessions were held with Focus Group to draft NISP for the college, prepare a plan of action, constitution of Councils, and the modus operandi for formulation, adoption, and implementation of NISP. The ideas, observations, and suggestions were kept in mind, while drafting the policy and suitably incorporated in the policy documents. The Management members, senior faculty members were also involved.
4. Faculty members were requested to purvey the adoption of NISP among students, peers, and counterpart in other HEIs.
5. Institutional Innovation Cell was formed at Institution level as per IIC guidelines and the coordinator registered at IIC portal.
6. Faculty members were informed to participate in the nationwide webinars, on National Education Policy conducted by various organisations. Accordingly, faculty members have participated in the online seminars, conclave, panel discussions conducted by Central Government, MoE, UGC, AIMA, Bangalore Management Association, Bangalore University, HEIs, National Education conclave (Heart full campus), and other professional Institutes of repute. The participation in these webinars helped the faculty members to appreciate the NEP initiatives and NISP objectives and provisions.
7. Faculty members are also resource persons, in webinars of HEIs on NEP and NISP and other related topics.
8. An awareness programme was held online for the benefit of all concerned.
9. Meeting of the Alumni members was invited to participate in the online meeting of their Alma matter, where members were apprised of the adoption of NISP, its objectives and other provisions regarding adoption of NISP, with a request to involve themselves in SAISP activities and to become members of Councils, Committees, and Sub Committees.
10. To get first-hand information and virtual experience, all concerned were directed to watch You Tube, Social media postings, websites of HEI etc, and make notes of the same for a better understanding keeping in view of their career - the career of the students, their skill development - to unearth their potentials and innovative thinking.

11. It is being contemplated to hold study circle meetings periodically, under Sri Aurobindo Collegiums, involving selected HEIs faculty members, students in the neighbouring areas of this college, for exchange of views and to obtain suggestions from them for proper implementation of SAISP strategies.
12. Plans are on the anvil, for conducting National level Idea Generation webinar for students and faculty members separately to generate Business opportunities under the auspices of SAISP.
13. It is proposed to conduct more awareness programmes/webinars/seminars/training programmes/workshops for the interested students and faculty. The tentative schedule is as follows:
